Directions for Use

Feed out in troughs suitable for liquid feeding. Sheltered troughs are recommended.

Always ensure that stock have fresh drinking water.

Do not feed HIGH IMPACT to starving stock, as high consumption can be toxic

eg: Cattle: 5 kg / head / day

Sheep: 1 kg / head / day

High Impact is not a complete feed by itself. Always ensure that stock have a bulk of roughage to complement High Impact.

Check consumption levels regularly.

If storing HIGH IMPACT for any length of time, ensure product is well mixed before being fed out.

Recommended consumption levels:

Cattle: 1—2kg / Head / Day

Sheep: 150—250gm / Head / Day

NB: Levels can increase in times of drought

Do not feed to horses, pigs or deer.

WARNING: This product contains Urea that maybe harmful to animals if not properly administered. Do not feed to starving animals or animals in poor condition. Make sure that a bulk of roughage is always available when feeding this product. Rain may cause this product to deteriorate. Do not feed out other Urea products while feeding this product
