PROTEIN 50 contains high levels of bypass protein, crushed grains and urea to make the most of standing dry feed, or to compliment grain feeding programs. The balanced protein blend in this block, combined with the high mineral, trace element and vitamin levels, helps ensure that stock will perform to their highest genetic potential on dry feed conditions, in a safe, efficient and effective way.

Average Consumption rates:

Grown Cattle: 200-500g per head per day

Weaner Cattle: 100-200g per head per day

Grown Sheep: 50-100g per day

Feeding Rates:

Grown Cattle: Approx. 8 blocks per 100 head 7 days

Grown Sheep: Approx. 6 block per 100 head 20 days

Note: Average block consumption can double in poor conditions.

Net Weights: 25kg and 80kg blocks

Make sure that a bulk of roughage is always available when feeding this product. Rain may cause this product to deteriorate.
