PRO 90 is a premium 30% urea, bypass/ lupin combination protein block for cattle grazing dry feed.

As dry feed deteriorates, the need for a high quality pasture supplement is critical in keeping cattle performing on low protein pastures.

PRO 90 allows the cattle's rumen function to operate at maximum efficiency during nutritional challenges. The nutritional combination in PRO 90 allows cattle to increase dry feed conversions to more energy and protein in their diet, effectively allowing them to keep producing calves on otherwise poor quality pasture. By increasing rumen stimulation, PRO 90 makes your pasture and grasses go much further, effectively saving time and money on importing feed sources onto your property.

PRO 90 ensures that all your dry feed is fully used.

PRO 90's new tropical strength formula guarantees a harder and more compact block, that reduces over consumption by hungry stock. With average consumption rates between 100—200 grams, per head per day, PRO 90 allows a true budgeted feeding program to be undertaken with confidence, knowing that cattle will thrive on dry pasture and PRO 90 at an economical daily feeding rate.

Average Consumption rates:

Cattle:

100 – 200g per head per day



Sheep:

10 – 15g per head per day



Feeding Tip:

Before feeding PRO 90, we advise to always feed out SALT or 10% Urea blocks first, for a period of 7 days—This will help prepare Rumen Bacteria for High Urea feeding.

Net Weights: 30kg and 100kg blocks

WARNING: This product contains Urea that maybe harmful to animals if not properly administered. Do not feed to starving animals or animals in poor condition. Make sure that a bulk of roughage is always available when feeding this product. Rain may cause this product to deteriorate. Do not place this product near dams or creeks as cattle may roll block into water. Do not feed out other Urea products while feeding this product
